Opening Song: Next Step

Cue Background Music: light, pensive

From stage right PENELOPE enters and as she talks trips on flower pot, then walks into tree near stage left.

PENELOPE: It's just another day at school, the same things happen over and over again. (Looks up) Lord, I need a little excitement in my life! (Trips over a flower pot) Oops! Don't get me wrong, Lord, I love serving you, I love telling other people about you; but nobody in this town seems to want to listen. Nobody seems to want to hear about Jesus.

BROCK: (Sarcastic) Hey, penny-loafer, your mom and a weird lady are here to see you. They're in the principle's office.

Fade Background Music / Cue SFX: doomsday snippet

PENELOPE: (Drops notebooks on ground as she hears "principle's office") The name's Penelope and why would my mom come to school to see me?

TRISHA: (Sarcastically) I don't know. Maybe you're in trouble? But it's hard to imagine that Miss Goody-Good is in trouble. Wow. That would be "shocking!" (Both puppets exit down)

PENELOPE: (Looking over her shoulder and bumping into a tree) I'm not in trouble. Ouch! (Walking fast down center aisle then around and up stage right side to soldier at puppet stage. To herself, doubting herself) I don't think I'm in trouble.

On stage left is table with Principle and Mom sitting in chairs. The queen is a puppet and went to the restroom.

Cue Background Music: sneaky, playful, light

Soldier is standing perfectly still -like the ones in front of London's Buckingham's palace. Penelope walks by the soldier, then backs up her steps. Walks backwards to look at soldier. She waves her hand before his eyes. He doesn't flinch. She looks at audience as if to say "watch this" and she makes a funny face at him. Nothing works, she gives up and walks over to principal's desk.

Fade Background Music

PRINCIPAL: Ah, Miss Penelope Puffinstuff, your mother is here to see you. She has someone she wants you to meet.

PENELOPE: Hi, mom. Is everything okay?



MOM: Hello, dear. I'm sorry to surprise you. Actually, it's a bit of a surprise for me, too. In a moment, I want to introduce you to your grandmother, Immelia Puffinstuff. From a small country named Rustonia.

PENELOPE: Grandmother? Wow! I didn't even know I had a grandmother.

MOM: Well, it's a little more complicated...

QUEEN: (Talking to someone stage right) Ta, ta now, Mrs. Lopez. I enjoyed your math class!
(Then fixes her hair and makeup while the others talk for a second)

PENELOPE: Mom, who is that lady wearing a, tiarra? Is that my...

MOM: Yes, dear, that's your grandmother. Queen of Rustonia.

Cue SFX: trumpet fan fair as queen in introduced

QUEEN: Why hello there...you must be Penelope Petunia Pattington Puffinstuff!

PENNY: (Nervously asking) I-I-I don't think I'm all that. Am I mom?

MOM: Well, actually, there's more.

PENNY: (Upset) I have an even longer name?

QUEEN: Your mother is talking about adding your title on to the front.

PENNY: My title? Like "Miss America?"

MOM: No dear, if grandmother is a queen, then, you are a...

PENNY: (Opens her eyes big and opens mouth and looks at the audience) **No way!**

MOM: (A little nervous in telling her) **Yes, way.**

PENNY: I'm a... **No way on earth!**

QUEEN: (Confidently) **Yes way, on earth and in heaven. You are...**

PENNY: (Interrupting) **A princess? Me? Ahhhhh! (Faints)**

They help her up and walk her off to stage left and out the door.
Soldier marches behind puppet stage to follow queen.
Be very sharp as you turn corners.

WORSHIP LEADER: Can you imagine the shock of finding out that you are a real, I mean, a real princess? Or prince? Your whole life would be turned up-side down. Would you be afraid? Happy? Scared? You would have some big decisions to make. Who would you turn to for help?



Cue Song: Fear Not (shortened)

Brock and Trisha up from puppet stage.

BROCK: Hey, Trisha, did you hear what happened?

TRISH: No, Brock, but news travels fast when you get it. What's up?

BROCK: The word is that we now have a real princess at our school. Princess Penny-loafer Puffinstuff. What a joke...

TRISH: You're kidding. She's a princess? A real princess?

BROCK: Yeah, over some small do nothing country. She's a joke.

TRISH: (Enamored with the thought of being a princess) A real princess. Princess Penelope. Wow! She's so lucky. She's gonna have everything in the world she wants. Wow. I would love to be in her shoes.

BROCK: Hey, maybe she'll move to that other country, and we won't have to hear her talk about God, and all that Jesus freak stuff. This princess thing could get rid of her for good.

Cue Background Music: pretty princess music

Hairdresser girl #1 carries mirror and places it in front of the princess, princess has her back to audience while hairdresser #2 carries hand mirror and brushes and hair spray
 Princess has a robe over a fancy dress, her hair in a towel but it is already done in a weird style which was quickly put up during last scene or can be a wig. Two hair dresser ladies holding brushes and mirrors and lead Penelope out to the chair stage left.

JAUQUE PIERRE: Now, zwee will create a beee-aautiful princess. (Takes towel off and two hair dresser ladies get out of the way so everyone can see. They turn the chair around so audience can see her and take robe off so dress is revealed. She has one big braid up in the air like a unicorn) Ahhhh, voila! You look!

PENELOPE: (Horrified, looking at audience) Like a unicorn.

JAUQUE: But a very cute unicorn. Singing a song of love: "Ahhwoogah" mes amies (Mayz amee), Doesn't she look lovely?

KIDS: No!

PENELOPE: I think I need a break from all this princess primping. I need a quiet moment. (Looks over her shoulder at Jaque and the ladies) Alone! Please. (All others exit stage left while princess walks to center stage to sing and then to sit down on rock.)



WORSHIP LEADER: Everybody needs to have a quiet time with the Lord. We need to sought things out and think it over. We can go into our very own prayer closet and find comfort and peace.

Cue Song: No Worries

PENELOPE: I'm not sure if I'm meant to be. (Stands up and begins to walk down aisle) The Princess of Rustonia. Please make it clear, Lord? (Exits down aisle)

Mom and queen come up center stage.

Cue Background Music: low, concerned, troubled

MOM: I'm worried about her. This is happening all too fast.

QUEEN: She's doing fine. Besides, she has everything to gain, and only a little to give up.

MOM: No...you're wrong. Queen Imelia, this girl loves God. She loves to go to church. She loves to share Jesus with her friends.

QUEEN: Oh, dear. That will never do. Royalty can't take sides, especially when it comes to religion. We have to be totally neutral. You know, let everybody know we don't have any favorites when it comes to God.

MOM: But Imelia, for Penny, there is only one God. And she will never be able to compromise and say that any God is okay, because it's not a religion to Penny. It's Jesus. Her Savior, her best friend, the one true God.

Fade Background Music

Enter Penny from down center aisle to front stage.

PENELOPE: I heard what you said, grandmother.

QUEEN: Penelope, is that you? You look like a...

PENELOPE: I know, a unicorn. That's the price we princesses have to pay!

QUEEN: Are you ready to decide your future, Penelope. We will soon be leaving for Rustonia and your people will want to meet you because someday, you will be queen.

Cue Background Music: pensive, soft and sparce (Foster?)

PENELOPE: Thank you for thinking so highly of me, grandmother, that you would give me your crown. But I think I am always going to remain, a princess.

MOM: What do you mean, honey?

PENELOPE: I can't go to serve in Rustonia because I already serve, my King.

QUEEN: But you can't betray your country, or, your queen, your grandmother, can you?

PENELOPE: (To audience) Kids, I think you understand. Maybe you could help me. Grandmother, the King I serve is the King of all kings. His name is... (gestures to kids)

KIDS: Jesus!

PENELOPE: I could never compromise my love for Him because He gave all of Himself for me. He died on a... (gestures to kids)

KIDS: Cross!

PENELOPE: Because of Jesus' blood shed for me, I am a part of the King's royal family. I've been adopted by my heavenly Father, and everyone who believes in Jesus as Lord and Savior, becomes a son or daughter. If my father is the King, then I am already a royal. I'm already a what kids? (Touches her crown)

KIDS: A princess!

MOM: That's right, penny. You are God's princess, and so am I.

QUEEN: But you could be a real princess. Ruling over a whole country.

PENNY: But grandmother, I want to serve my King and tell others about Jesus and how He offers the gift of eternal life. I could never keep quiet about Jesus. I need to plant seeds of truth and then, God will bring the fruit: Many people will want Jesus to be their savior. This is what I want to do with my whole life. (Looks down) Thank you, anyway, grandmother. I hope you understand.

QUEEN: (A little cold and angry) I don't understand. But, I want to, and I love you my Princess Penelope. I can see why this King has chosen you for His kingdom. You are very loyal to Him.

MOM: He is an awesome king, Imelia. We could tell you more about Him, if you like.

QUEEN: Hmm. Come, let's have tea and crumpets and pop tarts in my chambers, and we'll talk more about Jesus.

Fade Background Music

PRINCESS: Let's go! I'll get the pop tarts! (Mom and daughter are arm in arm walking stage left)

MOM: And I'll get the tea! We'll meet you there!

QUEEN: (All alone on stage) Imagine, kids, she's giving up being a real princess of Rustonia, because she loves to tell others about Jesus. Would you do that?



KIDS: Yeah!

QUEEN: Hmm, I must get to know this Jesus. (Exits down)

TRISHA: Did you hear that? Penelope gave it all up because she wants to stay here and tell others about Jesus!

BROCK: Hey, kids, who in their right mind would want to do that?

KIDS: We would!

TRISHA: Maybe we should find out more about Jesus. (Exit both puppets)

BROCK: What?

WORSHIP LEADER: Boys, if you believe in Jesus as your Savior, then you are part of the royal family. You are a prince. Girls, guess what? If you believe in Jesus, you are a part of the royal family, and you are all, Princesses! Wow! God is so good to adopt us into His royal family. Let's go tell everyone out there about the love of Jesus! Then we will have one big huge family of God!

Repeat after me.

His unchanging plan
Has always been
To adopt us
Into His own family
By bringing us to Himself
Through Jesus Christ.
