BG: sneaky and low

SFX: straw slurping on the bottom of an  
empty glass

BG: "You Must Have Been A Beautiful Baby" SFX: game show clock, ticking sounds

SFX: "Jaws"

HARVEST CHILDREN'S MINISTRY - "ROCK THE WORLD"





OPENING SONG: Rock The World

All items brought out by the boy from side of stage standing across stage with mouse in the middle.

CUE BACKGROUND MUSIC: sneaky and low

**WORSHIP LEADER:** If you give a mouse a cookie,

From stage left boy brings cookie to mouse.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** He's going to ask for a glass of milk.

Boy brings glass of milk to mouse.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** When you give him the milk, he'll probably ask you for a straw.

Boy brings straw to mouse who puts it in milk.  
The mouse drinks up milk and then

CUE SFX: straw slurping on the bottom of an empty glass

The mouse picks up and turns milk glass upside down to show it's empty.  
The mouse licks lips.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** When he's finished, he'll ask for a napkin.

CUE BACKGROUND MUSIC: You Must Have Been A Beautiful Baby

Boy brings giant prop napkin.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** Then he'll want to look in a mirror to make sure he doesn't have a milk mustache.

Boy brings out giant prop mirror.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** When he looks into the mirror, he might notice his hair needs a trim. So he'll probably ask for a pair of scissors.

Boy brings giant prop scissors.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** When he's finished giving himself a trim, he'll want a broom to sweep up. He'll start sweeping.

Boy brings real broom and hands it to the mouse who sweeps on stage and moves down to floor and aisles to brush across kids feet!

CUE BACKGROUND MUSIC: "Flight of the Bumblebee"



**WORSHIP LEADER:** He might get carried away and sweep every room in the house.

Mouse gets down center aisle like a maniac and brooms all over faster and faster with music.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** He may even end up washing the floors as well!

Boy brings a giant costume sponge who rolls all over the ground to clean floor.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** When he's done, he'll probably want to take a nap.

Boy brings out sleeping bag, pillow and 'blankie.'

CUE BACKGROUND MUSIC: Rocky A Bye Baby

**WORSHIP LEADER:** You'll have to find a sleeping bag for him with a special 'blankie' and a pillow. He'll crawl in, make himself comfortable and fluff the pillow a few times. He'll probably ask you to read him a story.

Boy brings in big prop story book.

CUE BACKGROUND MUSIC: old time movie traumatic snippet

**WORSHIP LEADER:** So you'll read to him from one of your books, and he'll ask to see the pictures. When he looks at the pictures, he'll get so excited he'll want to draw one of his own. He'll ask for paper and crayons.

Boy brings in paper and crayons.

CUE SFX: game show clock, ticking sounds

**WORSHIP LEADER:** He'll draw a picture. When the picture is finished, he'll want to sign his name with a pen.

Boy brings in giant prop pen.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** Then he'll want to hang his picture on your refrigerator. Which means he'll need scotch tape.

Boy brings in the scotch tape.

CUE SFX: "Jaws"

Mouse mimes getting tape stuck to finger and then stuck to other hand and then can't get it off of arm without ripping hair off arm, yeoow!

**WORSHIP LEADER:** He'll hang up his drawing and stand back to look at it. Looking at the refrigerator will remind him that he's thirsty.



CUE SFX: a thirsty 'tinkle' sound

Mouse stares at refrigerator, then slowly turns to look at boy, who slowly looks at audience with a horrified look of, "Now what?"

WORSHIP LEADER: So, oh, no, kids, what do you think he's going to ask for?

KIDS: A glass of milk!

WORSHIP LEADER: He'll ask for a glass of milk. And chances are if he asks for a glass of milk,

Boy puts hands to head

WORSHIP LEADER: He's going to want a...

KIDS: Cookie!

CUE BACKGROUND MUSIC: Oh Happy Day

WORSHIP LEADER: A cookie, to go with it. (Mouse pats his tummy like, yeah! I'm hungry!)

Boy leaves the stage, and mouse chases after him!

WORSHIP LEADER: Kids, I'm a lot like that mouse, I have a lot of needs. It's a good thing God takes care of me and gives me what I need and not what I want, or I'd turn into the "cookie monster!"

Repeat after me:

Has given us everything we need  
For life and Godliness  
Through our knowledge of Him  
Who called us  
By His own glory  
And goodness.
