LIGHT CUE: up on worship leader stage right

WORSHIP LEADER: Good morning!

KIDS: Good morning!

WORSHIP LEADER: Everybody, stand up for Jesus, and let's sing praises to him!

OPENING SONG: The Next Step

WORSHIP LEADER: You remember last week, we met a boy named Master Wilfred. Wilfred can buy anything he wants, but is he happy?

KIDS: No!

WORSHIP LEADER: Wilfred's dad works for the United States government in Pakistan and Willy hardly ever gets to see his dad. He's sad about that! Did he get to go with his mother to Pakistan?

KIDS: No!

WORSHIP LEADER: In fact, Willy had to go to his Uncle Eggbert's house. The maids said Uncle Eggbert is crazy. What does Uncle Eggbert like to do....

KIDS: Invent things!

WORSHIP LEADER: That's right, he's an inventor! Uncle Eggbert has a dream. Does Willy have a dream?

KIDS: No!

WORSHIP LEADER: Willy knows a lot of Bible verses, but does he believe those verses?

KIDS: No!

WORSHIP LEADER: So Willy has a head knowledge about God but he doesn't have a heart for God! How sad. Oh, yeah, one more question: Does Willy think friends are important?

KIDS: No!

WORSHIP LEADER: Let's go to Uncle Eggbert's back yard where the bar-b-que and Bible study will happen. Remember, Wilfred didn't want to go to the bar-b-que. He said he was going to bed. But, I don't think he's gonna want to miss the surprise!

LIGHT CUE: down stage right, up on the floor in front of stage right

CUE BACKGROUND MUSIC: country fiddle music

UNCLE EGGBERT: (Down floor stage right He has a spatula in hand and the hot dogs are already on a plate. He hands one to his friends, Melvin, Beufford and they walk back up to sit down on side of stage) Hey, Melvin, Beufford, here's your fifth hot dog!

**MELVIN:** Whooo-wee! Them dogs are good.

**BEUFFORD:** (Holding tummy) I think those dogs are beginning to bark! My tummy hurts. But I think I can eat just one more!

**ELLA:** Mr. Eggbert, I hope you don't mind, but I asked some of my church friends to come over to share some Bible in song. Like a Bible concert!

**MRS. MELVIN:** Mrs. Beufford, am I gonna need earplugs?

**MRS. BEUFFORD:** Ehhh? What'd ya say?

**MRS. MELVIN:** Oh, never mind!

**UNCLE EGGBERT:** Wow! Ella, that's wonderful!. I just wish Willy had stayed up to see em.

**ELLA:** Oh, I think he still might hear 'em. Hey, there they are!

FADE BACKGROUND MUSIC

Harvest Kids' Praise Club enters from stage left and right.

LIGHT CUE: up on the entire stage

**ELLA:** Mr. Eggbert and friends, this is the Harvest Kids' Praise Club! Hi, everybody!

**KPC:** Hi! Everybody!

**VALENTINA:** Thanks for having us over, Mr. Eggbert. We'd like to do just a few songs for you. First, we'd like to share about one of the miracles that Jesus performed -this song shows how important it is to have friends. It's about three friends who want to help their paralyzed friend get to Jesus! It's called "Tear The Roof Off!" Okay, here we go!

CUE SONG: Tear The Roof Off

**MELVIN:** Wow, Beufford, I would like to do that for you.

**BEUFFORD:** Thanks, Melvin. Keep prayin'. I'm hoping to get my muscles back in shape so I can work again! God has a plan, old friend!

**UNCLE EGGBERT:** He surely does!

**CHARLES:** The next song is about how God can do miracles through his disciples! That's you and me! It's called: In the name of Jesus. Sing along with us on the chorus.

CUE SONG: In The Name Of Jesus

CUE SFX: cell phone ring

**UNCLE EGGBERT:** I'll get it. (Gets up and steps down stairs and out of sight for a little, until first chorus, then comes back to sit down.)

MRS. MELVIN: Now, that's music!

DOC: Mrs. Melvin, that was Eggbert's phone!

AUDREY: Our last song is about life. Sometimes, we may feel like we're on a wild roller coaster. We can't see where we're going and the ride is bumpy!

SARAI: But, by faith, we know that Jesus is with us. When we ask Him to be our Savior, we know that He died on the cross for us!

ELLA: Yeah, and He didn't have to do it! But He loved us so much, He saved us from sin and death.

AUDREY: That's right, Ella. And because Jesus rose from the dead, we will, too! We have his promise that we will live in heaven forever! So hey, don't be afraid to take "The Ride Of Your Life" and live for Jesus!

CUE SONG: In The Name Of Jesus

TORI: Thanks, again, Ella. We've got to head out. See you at church!

ELLA: Okay, see you there!

UNCLE EGGBERT: Thanks, kids! That was great worship. Come back any time.

CUE BACKGROUND MUSIC: The Ballet (Foster)

MRS. MELVIN: Well, we better hit the trail. Melvin, let's pray and pack it up!

MRS. BEUFFORD: Yes, Beufford, no racing Melvin up the hill!

UNCLE EGGBERT: I'll close in prayer. Lord, thank you for the music and the worship. Bless these friends and bless Willy. In Jesus name I pray.

EVERYONE: Amen.

UNCLE EGGBERT: See y'all next week!

ALL OTHERS: Goodnight!

Uncle Eggbert walks over to the grill and gets the plate and spatula to wash.

WILFORD: I heard the music...

UNCLE EGGBERT: Oh, I thought you were sleeping.

WILFORD: No, I couldn't sleep. So, I snuck out to listen to the kids. They seemed nice . What they said ....Made a lot of sense.

UNCLE EGGBERT: What part?

FADE BACKGROUND MUSIC

CUE BACKGROUND MUSIC: Morning to Morning (Foster)

WILFORD: I guess everybody needs friends. Good friends. And I guess. I know a lot of facts about Jesus -but I don't love him like, you do.

UNCLE EGGBERT: Well, since he already loves you, would you like to invite him into your heart. To be your best friend and savior. That's a good way to start getting closer to him.

WILFORD: Yeah, I think, I would, oh, and Uncle Eggbert, I'm sorry I called you, "egghead."

UNCLE EGGBERT: That's okay, Willy, I figured it was just a yoke! Get it?

WILFORD: I get it!

UNCLE EGGBERT: Let's pray. (Both bow heads)

FADE BACKGROUND MUSIC

UNCLE EGGBERT & WILFORD: Amen (As music fades)

CUE BACKGROUND MUSIC: We're Expecting A Miracle

WILFORD: I have a question, Uncle Eggbert. That dream of yours, how does this thing fit in? (Holds up pink funnel hose)

UNCLE EGGBERT: Oh, hee-hee. My dream is to find ways to help people! So, I've invented things for my friends. You remember when you shook Beufford's hand?

WILFORD: Yes, and his handshake felt like a dead fish!

UNCLE EGGBERT: That's right, that's because Beufford is losing his muscle tone. It's some kind of disease where he doesn't have strength any more in his hands.

WILFORD: Oh! No!

UNCLE EGGBERT: Beufford owns a dairy and he can't milk the cows by hand anymore. So, I invented this.

WILFORD: (Looks at audience with a funny look) You mean, this thing, that was on my head, is the thing that goes under the cow, on the...

UNCLE: That's right, it's an utter-ly good idea that will help Beufford keep his dairy!

WILFORD: Yuk, Uncle Eggbert, you are a good man!

UNCLE EGGBERT: I have a great God, Willy, and now, so do you. Oh, and by the way, there was a phone call during the concert. It was your dad. He misses you, will, he and your mom are coming to stay here for a while. Your dad wants to take you on a fishing trip before he heads back to Pakistan.

WILFORD: Me and my dad? Fishing? Alright. This may be the best summer ever! Come to think of it, I've got a new best friend—it is the best summer ever.

**UNCLE EGGBERT:** I'm gonna hit the hay, tiger. Tomorrow, you and me are gonna try this new invention out!

**WILFORD:** On a cow? (As they both walk to exit stage left)

SLOWLY FADE BACKGROUND MUSIC

**UNCLE EGGBERT:** That's where the milk comes from, egghead! (Off stage together)

**WILFORD:** Hey, did you just call me egghead?!?

**UNCLE EGGBERT:** Goodnight, Willy!

**WORSHIP LEADER:** Wow! Willie asked Jesus into his heart. He is truly a rich boy now. Growing in the riches of Jesus!
